REVISED COVID-19 SAFETY PROTOCOLS EFFECTIVE JULY 6, 2021

SAN BERNARDINO, CA— San Bernardino Superior Court (SBSC) is removing certain COVID-19 safety protocols in conformance with updated state and local public health guidance and newly adopted Cal/OSHA regulations.

Beginning Tuesday, July 6, all social distancing requirements will be removed. Fully vaccinated court users, including jurors, justice partners, attorneys, and members of the public, may remove their face covering once vaccination status has been verified at the courthouse entrance. To verify your status, all court users must show proof of vaccination. Justice partners should follow verification procedures as outlined in separate communication and should contact their supervisor for details. Any person unable to prove vaccination status, will be asked to wear a face covering or be provided one, at no-cost, if needed.

Security personnel will turn away any person not following this procedure. SBSC continues to follow all state and [local public health orders](#) to ensure the safety of all court users, judicial officers and employees while balancing access to justice during the COVID-19 pandemic.

As a reminder, do not come into any court location if you have COVID-19, are unvaccinated and have been exposed to someone with COVID-19, feeling ill, or have been asked to quarantine by a healthcare professional.
